provide immediate safety and security for victims of domestic violence and their children.

Emergency Shelter provides housing for adults and children for up to 60 days in a safe, secure and confidential location. Throughout their stay, residents gain confidence, become empowered and obtain support while transitioning into the next stage of their lives.

Interim Housing is a unique program which recognizes that barriers to securing housing often exist for victims of domestic violence. As such, extended shelter stays and support services are offered. During their stay, clients work with counselors and case managers to address barriers, identify resources and secure housing.

Transitional Housing provides a bridge to permanent housing for victims who have benefitted from emergency shelter or other support services at the Crisis Center. Individuals and families can stay for up to 24 months in scattered site apartments while working on emotional stability, financial security and self-sufficiency.
